

During the Spring Term we will travel back over 5000 years to discover what life was like among the pyramids of Ancient Egypt. Our lessons are set to be filled with Pharaohs, Sphinx and a Mummy or two as we travel the curriculum from subject to subject.

#### Literacy

Within Spring One we will devote our time to recapping and enhancing our Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling skills. This will help to prepare us for some exciting fiction and non-fiction writing in Spring Two. In Spring Two we will spend time exploring performance poetry, writing instructions on how to mummify a Pharaoh and write diary entries from Howard Carter.

# **Vipers**

Within our daily sessions we will study the story 'Marcy and The Riddle of The Sphinx' in Spring One and 'Flat Stanley and The Great Tomb Robbery' in Spring Two. We'll use the text to discover what life was like in Ancient Egypt and to further develop our reading comprehension skills. Each session will focus on a different area of the VIPERS acronym.

#### Mathematics

We will continue our work looking at multiplication and division before moving on to explore perimeter within our measurement sessions. Within Spring Two our studies will cover fractions and capacity and mass.

#### Science

The Ancient Egyptians had strong attitudes towards light and so this will heavily influence our enquiries within Spring One as we explore light and shadow. Spring Two will see us heading outdoors as we continue our studies on plants.

#### Humanities

Ancient Egypt is our main focus within Humanities this term. We'll learn what life was like 5000 years ago whilst studying the artefacts the Egyptians have left behind.

# **Jigsaw**

In Spring One we will look at our Dreams and Goals and how we can build our resilience to achieve our targets. In the second half of the term our Jigsaw encompasses 'Healthy Me' where we will learn about keeping happy and healthy.

# D&T

The theme for our lessons this term is 'Mechanics' and we will study pneumatic toys in order to design and create our own 'Nile Crocodile' toys for Ancient Egyptian children.

#### PE

We will develop our skills using of space through different levels, directions, balances & pathways in gym/dance with timing & rhythm. We will also be working towards swimming on front or back over 25m. We will be discussing how the values within our Toolkit link to sport, the wider curriculum and beyond.

#### Art

Our Ancient Egyptian inspired Art sessions will see us creating our own paper and making our own scrolls.

# French

This term we will continue our work exploring the language by learning to say the months of the year, the country we live in and the languages we speak.

# Computing

Within our computing sessions we will be exploring the wonderful world of animation in order to create our own films.

# RE

We will begin the term by looking at what Christians learn from the story of Noah's Ark and begin our studies in Hinduism.

# Music

We will explore some Egyptian inspired melodies as we develop our skills experimenting with pitch, notation, rhythms and composing.
