Autumn Term

This term, in science, we will be learning about the human body, how our organs work and the vital functions they perform. Then we'll move on to animal habitats and how we classify animals and plants. We'll be looking at European and Cornish geography and how Cornwall differs to elsewhere in the world. The class will also learn about the water cycle and how that impacts Wadebridge. In history we'll be starting to explore the world of the Ancient Greeks; how we know so much about them and how we can work out what their everyday life was like.

- Multiply by 1 and 0

Science – We will learn about the human body, organs and their functions, food chains and food webs. We'll then learn about animal habitats and animal and plant classification.

Computing – The internet, websites and webpages; audio editing and podcasts.

Art – We will learn how to use tints and shades to give a three-dimensional effect when painting, how paint can create different effects and consider proportion and composition when creating a still-life painting.

D&T – We will be designing, making and evaluating a book sleeve.

PE – Developing skills: passing, moving, creating space and dribbling through a variety of sports. We will be discussing how the values in our Toolkit for Learning, Love and Laughter link to sport and the wider curriculum.

RE – Hinduism: does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?

Christianity: What is the 'Trinity' and why is it important for Christians?

Music – We will sing a broad range of unison songs with the range of an octave. Listen to recorded and live performances from a range of contexts and discuss story, origin, history and social context.

French – Pets, saying their names and describing them.

PSHE – The children will explore 'Being Me in My World' and 'Celebrating Differences'.
