


Sustainability

Literacy

This term we are working on how to write a vivid character description, using powerful word choices. We are looking at what a good introduction to a piece of writing looks like, how do we hook the reader in and make them want to keep reading? The class will create their own mythical character to write about.

Maths

In our maths lessons this term we will be exploring decimals, money, shape, statistics, position and direction and learning how to tell the time.

Science


In science we will be investigating how sound is made and finding patterns between pitch and features of the object that makes it. Then we move on to electrical circuits, creating them and making loops with a lamp.
