This policy provides a clear framework for how our school communicates with families, including the ways in which parents and carers can ensure they are fully involved in every aspect of the school community and support their children's learning.

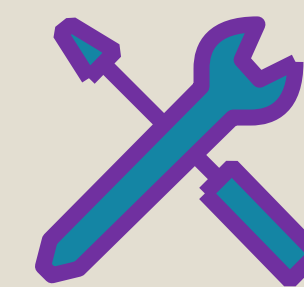

## 2. Roles and Responsibilities – for parents



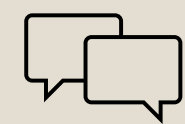
Read key communications and respond/act on these, e.g, attending meetings or supporting requests.

Raising any concerns they may have with the school.



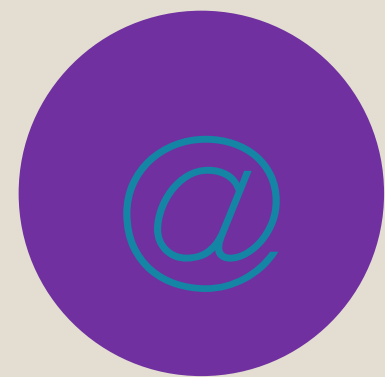
Engaging in opportunities to provide feedback.

able to address class teachers before the start and end of each school day for urgent matters,

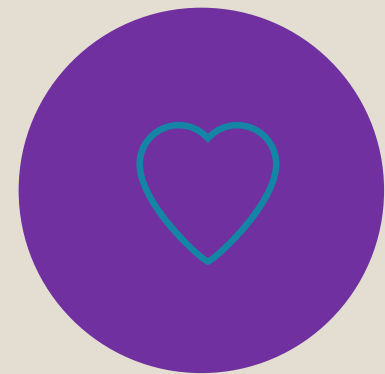
able to view celebration of pupil progress on the school's social media channels,

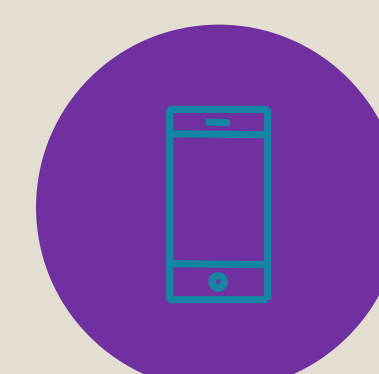

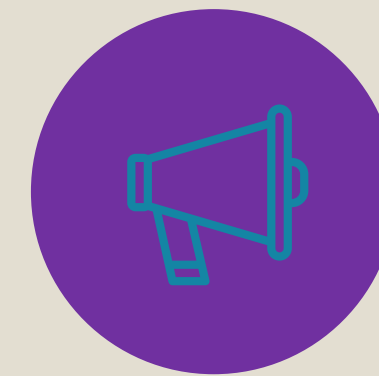



The school aims to support parents in every way possible to help them with the educational development and wellbeing of their child.



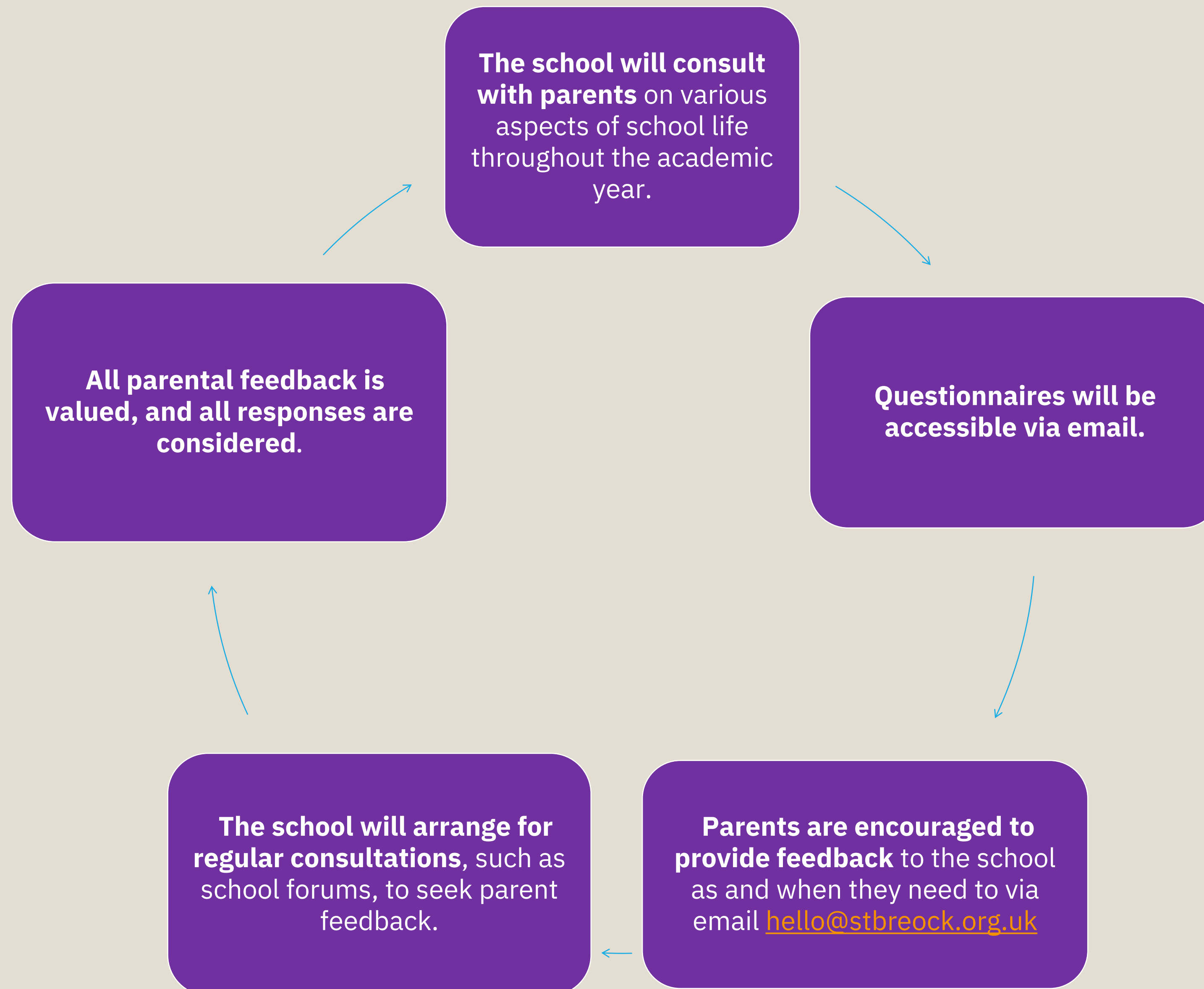
The school runs various assemblies, training sessions, coffee mornings and opportunities to help parents with issues they and their child may face.
